The Road May be Closing, but we are Definitely NOT!

Rumors are flying subsequent to the pending Route 11&15 road closure south of BMO this summer (May 1 – July 31). If you're approaching from the south (using Route 81) don't listen to the sexy voice on your GPS, Google, or whatever device you're used to unless you want to take the official 27 mile (one way; 54 mile round trip!) detour; we've got a much shorter and more scenic route for you (hopefully we'll have signage to help you find us):

Take Exit 65 off Route 81 and follow the signs for 11&15 South (Enola). Veer right at the traffic light, then take the first right, onto First Street. Turn right at the road that has the "Capital Area Intermediate Unit" sign. Follow to the end, and turn Right on Bella Vista Drive. Continue all the way to the stop sign in Marysville. Turn left at the stop sign (into the tunnel). Veer right at the top of the tunnel to the stop sign. Turn right on Valley Road, then right at the stop light (note, no turn on red). Our shop is just ahead on the left. There are parking lots on both sides of the building. (If you are coming for a trip or picking up boat(s) please use the second parking lot, past the building.)

PLEASE stay within the speed limit and plan some extra time; also watch for kids in the road; this is usually a very quiet street, and they may not be prepared for the up-tic in traffic. Coming from the north? Not to worry: directions are still the same.

Our shop is bursting with canoes, kayaks, stand up boards and all the toys to go with them, and our staff is ready to get you on the water!


